RALLY AGAINST KOLKATA HORROR

On 19th August a massive protest was organized by Maratha Mandal group of institutions condemning the tragic rape and murder of a female trainee doctor at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata in West Bengal, on Aug 9. Students and faculty of different institutions of Maratha Mandal lead by the President took a protest march from the head office via Channamma circle to the DC office and blocked the traffic at Channamma circle for an hour to raise the general public's awareness and to mobilize support for call to get justice for the doctor. 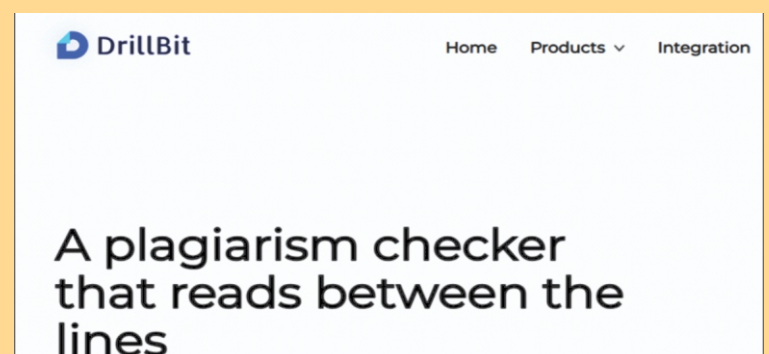
ORIENTATION PROGRAM ON RESEARCH FOR FACULTY AND PG STUDENTS

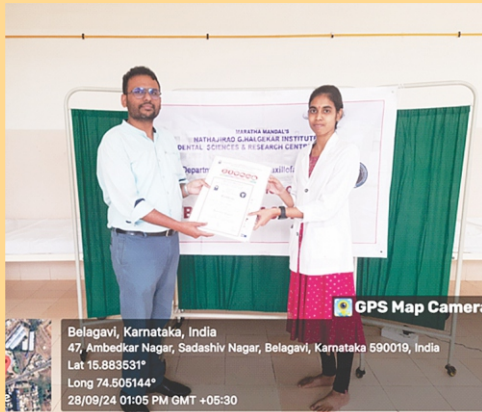

BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING PROGRAMME (BLS)

This programme was started in 2016 on World Heart Day and has been continuing successfully. BLS generally refers to the type of care that first-responders, healthcare providers and public safety professionals provide to anyone who is experiencing cardiac arrest, respiratory distress, or an obstructed airway. It requires knowledge and skills in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), using automated external defibrillators (AED) and relieving airway obstructions in patients of every age.

The candidates were trained over 2 days, 27th and 28th Sep24. On the first day of the programme a pre workshop test was conducted to assess the basic knowledge of the participants. Then the lectures and hands on demonstrations were given to the participants over two days. During the programme various real-life examples were given to make them understand the concept of BLS and to perform BLS. The participants were trained individually and once they had learnt the technique of BLS, a post work shop assessment in MCQ, OSCE and OSPE pattern was conducted.

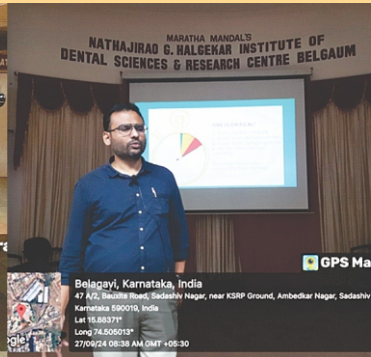
During the programme the candidates were provided CPR masks individually. The candidates were trained on interactive mannequins and AED. All the aspects of BLS were covered. After successful completion of the course the 19 Postgraduate students and 3 staff were presented with a certificate and a placard of BLS training.
